Linda Armstrong Kelly Coming to Kansas City Mother of seven-time Tour De France champion and cancer survivor Lance Armstrong coming to Kansas City to speak to pregnant teens.

KANSAS CITY, MO ô SEPTEMBER 27, 2010 ô Linda Armstrong Kelley, mother of seven-time Tour De France champion and cancer survivor Lance Armstrong, will be in Kansas City on Thursday, October 7th to speak at 2:00pm to a group at Wornall Road Baptist Church (400 W Meyer Boulevard), with a reception to follow. This event is hosted by the Light House, a nonprofit organization helping pregnant young women in Kansas City. Ms. Armstrong Kelly became pregnant with Lance at the age of seventeen, and has personally battled the cycle of poverty and abuse. She will share her inspiring and encouraging story of how she went from a statistic to a success while raising a son by herself. This free event is open to the public.

Ms. Armstrong Kelly is in Kansas City at the invitation of Chrissy Haley, wife of Kansas City Chiefs Head Coach Todd Haley. Mrs. Haley and other Kansas City Chiefs wives will be at this event to help support the Light House.
